The Team Building Approach

Step One: Pre-Workshop Data Collection

Prior to the Team Building Workshop, each participant provides data (via surveys and/or interviews) related to team building topics. These data are compiled, summarized, and used to select the topics for the team building workshop.

Step Two: Team Building Workshop

This workshop employs concept briefings, small group discussions and presentations, role play, case study practices, and real issue applications. Participants learn, experience, practice, apply, understand, and develop the competencies critical to building a cohesive and productive team. The critical competencies may be identified from the Pre-Workshop Data Collection. Some possible competencies/topics, which may be identified from the Pre-Workshop Data Collection are:

- Team Purpose / Mission / Objectives
- Effective Human Interaction / Influence
- Conflict Resolution / Communication
- Team Roles & Team Rules (Guidelines)
- Problem Solving and Decision Making
- Team Meetings and Mechanics

Upon completion of the workshop, each participant will develop an Action Plan covering:
(1) What our team will do; (2) Who will help us do it; and (3) When it will be done.

Step Three: Post-Workshop Follow-Up (Optional)

Approximately six weeks following the completion of the team building workshop, the team will meet with the workshop facilitator to assess progress and plan for the continuing development of the team.
